



## Full Metal Mayrhofen returns to rock the mountains and valleys in 2027!

After the resounding success of the last two years' events, FULL METAL MAYRHOFEN is set to return to Zillertal from 29 March to 3 April 2027. With an impressive backdrop of snow-covered peaks, traditional mountain huts, and the incredible Alpine panorama of Mayrhofen, the festival will once again deliver an experience unlike any other in Europe. The event combines top-class metal performances with winter sports and an Alpine atmosphere. An initial line-up has already been confirmed and features Feuerschwanz, U.D.O., Dog Eat Dog, Rhapsody of Fire, Grave Digger, annisokay, Mittel Alta and Dying Eden.

The first two FULL METAL MAYRHOFEN events transformed Mayrhofen into a meeting place for metal fans from all over the world for an entire week. The whole town became part of the festival, be it on the ski slopes, at après-ski, or in the stage audience. Memorable concerts, an incredible atmosphere and the palpable enthusiasm of the many visitors characterised the event and underscored the unique character of FULL METAL MAYRHOFEN.

### First bands already confirmed for the next edition

Folk-metal heroes Feuerschwanz combine folk and heavy metal to create epic anthems full of energy, while heavy-metal legends U.D.O., fronted by Udo Dirkschneider, have been synonymous with uncompromising, classic metal for decades. Dog Eat Dog bring their unmistakable crossover sound – blending hardcore, punk and hip-hop – to the Zillertal, whilst Rhapsody of Fire create orchestral soundscapes with their monumental symphonic power metal. Grave Digger will also be heading to Mayrhofen, bringing more than 40 years of German heavy-metal history with them. annisokay deliver modern metal combining massive breakdowns, electronic soundscapes and powerful refrains, while Mittel Alta offer a wild mix of metal, rap, punk and thrash. Mayrhofen's local heroes Dying Eden can look forward to a true homecoming show.

### Locations

Following the tried-and-tested festival concept, concerts will once again take place at the Europahaus Mayrhofen from Monday to Wednesday, before the live shows move to the Forest Festival Stage for the remaining festival days. At the same time, a varied programme will also



be taking place at several venues on the Penken. More bands and programme highlights will be added to the line-up over the coming months – so it's worth staying up to date.

FULL METAL MAYRHOFEN is more than just a festival – it is an escape to one of Austria's most beautiful destinations. During the day, the slopes, mountain panorama and traditional mountain huts beckon, while guitars, mosh pits and an incomparable atmosphere take over in the evening.
