

Rules of Conduct for Ropeway Systems

- 1. Participation in a guided tour of a construction site or ropeway system is only possible after acknowledging and signing these rules of conduct.
- 2. Since participation in a guided tour of a construction site or ropeway system involves a certain risk of accidents (such as the risk of slipping, tripping, or falling due to uneven terrain), participation is at your own risk.
- 3. In the interest of your own safety, you must follow the instructions of our staff at all times. Failure to do so may result in your exclusion from further participation.
- 4. You must also pay close attention to all warnings.
- 5. Smoking and alcohol consumption are prohibited during the guided tour.
- 6. You must stay within the visitor areas and with your visitor group. In particular, you are prohibited from climbing scaffoldings or ladders or crossing barriers, etc.

If you have any doubt about whether you are permitted to enter a certain area, please ask a member of our staff beforehand.

- In particular, you are prohibited from touching moving parts of ropeway systems, construction machines, etc. Do not stand under suspended loads!
- 8. Parents must supervise their children at all times and are responsible for ensuring that they understand and respect these rules of conduct.

For safety reasons, children under the age of 6 cannot take part in a guided tour. Children who are at least 6 years old can take part as long as they are accompanied by an adult.

- 9. During the guided tour, you must wear and use the protective equipment provided.
- 10.Suitable clothing and shoes must be worn at all times. The use of ski boots is not recommended and leads to limited access to the premises. If you have any questions in this regard, please contact a member of our staff before the tour begins.
- 11. Animals are not permitted on the guided tour.
- 12.If the tour must be canceled or shortened (due to weather conditions, urgent work, etc.), you are to follow the instructions of our staff and leave the site immediately.
- 13. You confirm that you are physically fit enough to participate in the guided tour.
- 14. The areas covered by the guided tour are not barrier-free and therefore unfortunately not suitable for wheelchair users, persons with walking aids, etc.



15. Taking pictures for one's private use is allowed, but making audio and video recordings is prohibited.
