SUGGESTED WINTER HIKES

- 1 RIGI LAKE VIEW WALK** This easy alpine hike from Rigi Kulm to Rigi Kälbad is sure to thrill hikers with breathtaking vistas of Switzerland's heartland and a regular ocean of Alpine peaks in their winter attire. Point-to-point trail > 1 h / 4 km
- 2 RIGI PANORAMA TRAIL** Mount Rigi's longest hiking trail offers a wonderful 360-degree view of the Alpine scenery. Historic buildings as well as a tunnel and a viaduct are reminders of the old Rigi-Scheidegg railway. The trail leads from Rigi Kälbad to Rigi Scheidegg/Burggeist, or vice versa. Point-to-point trail > 2 h / 7 km
- 3 RIGI KLÖSTERLI TRAIL** The walk along this flat trail from Rigi Kälbad to Rigi First is as easy as can be. And the remainder of your stroll down to Rigi Klösterli by way of the Heirihütte Alpine inn is just as relaxing. Point-to-point trail > 45 min. / 2.2 km
- 4 SEEBODENALP WINTER HIKE** This easy hike from Seebodenalp mountain station to Räbalp and back rewards you with a clear view of Lake Lucerne and all the way to the horizon. It can be extended to Holderen via Seebodenalp vista point. Loop trail > 1 h / 2 km
- 5 ROTSTOCK TRAIL** This trail leads from Rigi Staffel via Rotstock to Rigi First, offering you plenty of great vistas along the way. Point-to-point trail > 50 min. / 2.2 km
- 6 MOUNT RIGI TIME TRAVEL TRAIL** This easy alpine trail will regale you with info about the Queen of the Mountains' 150-year history while offering many majestic vistas. It leads from Rigi Kulm Station by way of Rigi Staffelhöhe and Rigi Kälbad to Rigi Klösterli. Point-to-point trail > 1:30 h / 5.2 km

SNOWSHOE EXCURSIONS

- 1 CHÄSERENHOLZ TRAIL** This easy circular trail takes you through the snowy Alpine scenery, to the Chäserenholz area and then back to Rigi Kulm. 1:30 h / 2.4 km / 139 m cumulative elevation gain (c.e.g.)
- 2 FRUTTILI TRAIL** Treading lightly, you will carve your own tracks in the Fruttli area snow while enjoying the majestic Alpine panorama. 1 h / 2.5 km / 471 m c.e.g.
- 3 GRATALP TRAIL** Starting at Romiti, this trail takes you up to Grathöchi, where you will be rewarded with a breathtaking view of Lake Lucerne and Rigi Kulm. 2 h / 2 km / 368 m c.e.g.
- 4 RIGI SCHEIDEGG TRAIL** The Rigi Scheidegg-Burggeist area is the snowshoe aficionados' best-kept secret. And the perfect place to enjoy nature in all its peaceful glory. 2 h / 4 km / 155 m c.e.g.
- 5 RIGI BURGGEIST TRAIL** The 360-degree view of the Alps and the Swiss heartland that awaits you in the Burggeist area is an experience truly out of the ordinary. 1:45 h / 6 km / 187 m c.e.g.
- 6 FEISSENODEN TRAIL** While you are taking in the fabulous view of the Bernese Alps and Lake Lucerne, this trail will smoothly take you from Oberschwend to Rigi Burggeist. 2 h / 4.5 km / 540 m c.e.g.


VARIOUS

Rigi offers views of a literal ocean of 620 Alpine peaks and 13 lakes. Add to that glorious sunsets and – weather permitting – the imposing sea of fog below.




