- 1. Stoos ski region 35 kilometers of varied slopes and 8 lifts for young and old. broad attractive slopes of all difficulties (blue, red and black run) will win the heart of any winter sports lover. the stoos ski region is family-friendly and positioned on a high, sunny plateau.

- 1. Ski safari circuit illgau – mythenregion – hoch-ybrig – illgau 14 km | downhill slopes & restaurants. tickets available from illgau, handgrobühl, hoch-ybrig. if there is insufficient snow to prepare the slopes into illgau village, the ski safari circuit is not usable.

VILLAGE LIFE

Around 3'500 people live in the village of Muotatal, surrounded by thick forests and imposing alpine peaks. Much of village life revolves around local clubs and societies, with activities ranging from sustainability in the region to yodeling and local sports.

VILLAGE LIFE

A car-free village and skiing area within the commune of Morschach, Stoos Mountain Village lies 1300m above sea level on a high plateau. It has 150 locals, with around 16 children currently attending the village school. In tourist season, there is room for up to 2'200 visitors to stay in Stoos.

Re recuperative energy: the waste heat from the funicular's plant room is fed into modern heat pumps that keep the mountain station of the funicular Schwyz-Stoos, the Stoos Shop & Rental, over 100 rooms in the Stoos Lodge, and the Skilifts Sternegg building warm and cozy.

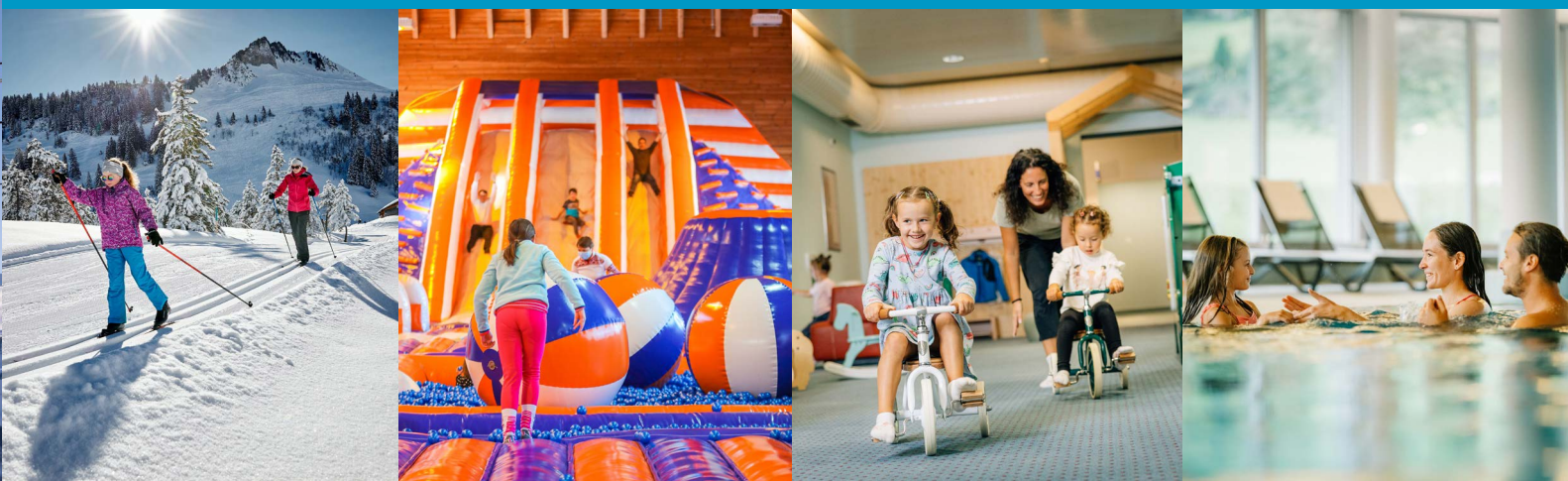

WETTERSCHMÖCKER

The home-grown 'Wetterschmöcker', sometimes known as the 'Muotathaler Wetterfrösche', is a group of hobby meteorologists from the region Inner-schwyz. Their own observations of nature are certainly an ingredient of their weather forecasts, but the exact recipe is a well-guarded secret. Learn more about weather and forecasting during an entertaining talk from one of these dyed-in-the-wool Schwyz veterans. The 'Wetterschmöcker' meet twice a year to present their forecasts with a wealth of wit and charm.

HISTORY

The association, formally named the Innerschwyz Meteorology Association, was founded in Muotatal in 1947. One of the catalysts leading to the group's formation was the emergence of radio and a fear that if everyone simply tuned into the weather forecast, the art of observing nature closely and predicting the weather would be lost to time.
